Motorbike rider had meth, cash, taser, baton in Kingsley stop

A motorbike rider was arrested on Wednesday after police pulled him over and discovered drugs, cash and weapons.

A MOTORCYCLIST was arrested on Wednesday after police pulled him over and discovered drugs, cash and weapons.

Police said they stopped the 23-year-old Hillarys man on the corner of Hepburn Avenue and Wanneroo Road, Kingsley, and searched the rider and motorbike.

They allegedly found methylamphetamine, cannabis, smoking implements, cash, a taser, an extendible baton and a canister of OC spray.

The man has been charged with failing to stop, no authority to drive, unlawful possession, ready access to both weapons and cash, possessing a prohibited weapon, two counts of possessing a prohibited drug with intent to sell/supply and possess a controlled weapon.

He is due to appear in the Perth Magistrates Court on Thursday.

After the traffic stop, police executed a search warrant on a Hillarys home in Deverall Square where police allegedly located a number of drug related items.

A second 23-year-old Hillarys man will appear in court at a later date on offences of cultivating a prohibited plant; possess a prohibited drug; possessing drug paraphernalia, and possessing unlicensed ammunition.
