

Two charged after threatening Carlisle man with taser, damaging yard

WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP >> According to Pennsylvania State Police, Carlisle, two Carlisle individuals were charged with simple assault after they harassed a man with a taser and damaged his yard.

Police report that on May 3 around 11:25 a.m., a man confronted Jonathan M. Lepperd, 19, Carlisle, and Cami J. Reynolds, 20, Carlisle, after one of their vehicles was parked in the 2000 block of Newville Road in his yard.

Once he confronted them, Reynolds got out of the vehicle and began to chase the man with a conducted electrical weapon, or taser, while Lepperd backed up into the man's lawn and spun out his tires in the lawn, causing damage.

The man retreated into the house while both individuals left the scene.
