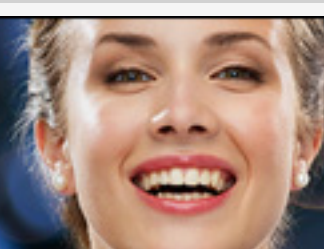

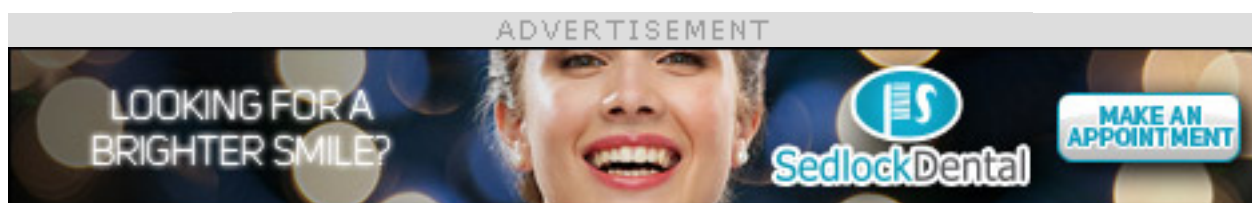

Man allegedly grabs taser, shocks police officer

Ladysmith (WQOW) - - A man has been accused of grabbing a police officer's taser and using it to shock the officer.

The Ladysmith Police Officer was responding to a report that Bradley Sleeter Jr was possibly intoxicated and was leaving a Ladysmith apartment in his car when the officer approached him. He said Sleeter rushed at him and attacked him.

Police said during the struggle Sleeter grabbed the officer's taser out of his holster and deployed it for seven seconds, shocking the officer's hand.

Sleeter also allegedly kicked the officer multiple times in the chest and face. Sleeter now faces eight criminal charges.

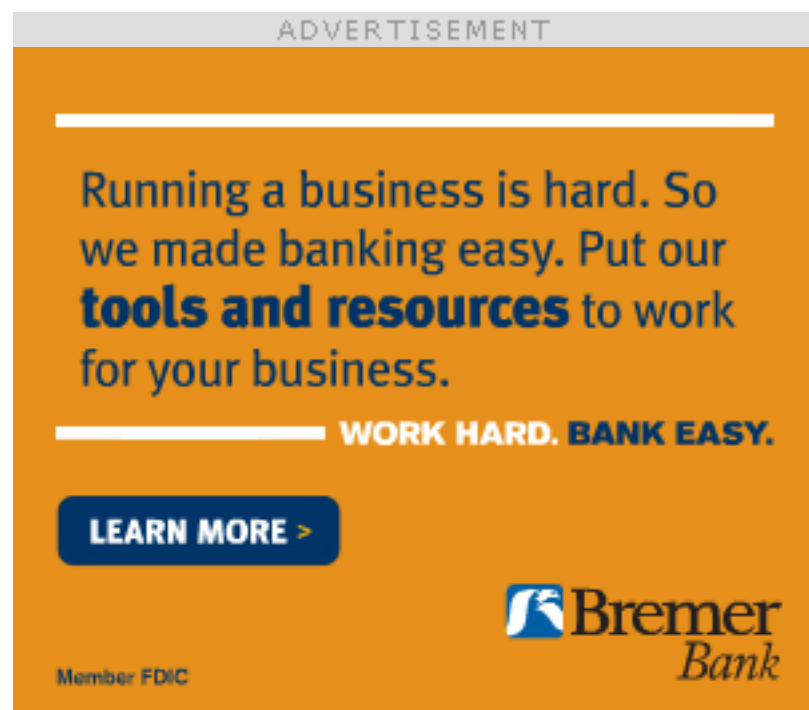
